ELITE CAMP

GIRLS ENTERING GRADES 9-12

JULY 9-11, 2019 (JULY 9TH 12:00PM-6:00PM, JULY 10TH 9:00AM-4:00PM, JULY 11TH 8:00AM-NOON)

This three-day camp will focus primarily on improving each participant's individual skills in individual and team situations. A portion of the camp will also feature live games where the camper will have an opportunity to showcase and hone their skills with Head Softball Coach Melanie Meuchel, the University of Montana softball coaching staff, and members of the 2019 team. Campers will receive a Griz softball camp tee shirt. Camp is limited to the first 72 campers with paid enrollment.

Fee: \$250 (Fee includes instruction, camp tee shirt, and lunch only on July 10th).

GIRLS ENTERING GRADES 3-8

AUGUST 5-7, 2019 ALL DAYS 8:00AM-12:00PM

This three-day camp offers young players the opportunity to learn, practice and improve overall softball skills. Various competitions and games will be held during the camp. Each camper will receive one-on-one time with Montana Head Softball Coach Melanie Meuchel as well as the Montana softball staff, plus current and former Griz softball players. Campers will receive a Griz softball camp tee shirt. Camp is limited to the first 72 campers with paid enrollment.

Fee: \$160 (Fees includes instruction and camp tee shirt).

CAMP STAFF

Melanie Meuchel, Montana Softball Head Coach

Coach Meuchel just completed her sixth season on staff and second as head coach, overseeing all aspects of the program. Under her tutelage, Montana pitching staff has continued to put up their best statistical year as a program and in the Big Sky Conference; four pitchers receiving BSC honors and Michaela Hood receiving BSC Tournament MVP honors. Meuchel helped guide Montana to four BSC Tournament appearances and a 2017 Big Sky Conference Championship. Prior to Montana, Meuchel helped Nevada to the 2008 and 2009 WAC regular season title and the 2006 WAC Tournament Championship, and to NCAA Tournament appearances in 2006, 2008 and 2009. Under her leadership, Katie Holverson received WAC Pitcher of the Year in 2009 and six different pitchers to All-Conference honors. Meuchel spent 2005 as a graduate assistant coach at the University of Oklahoma with their super regional team and two seasons at McNeese State. As a player, Meuchel helped pitch her team to the NCAA DII Women's College World Series at Colorado Mesa University (Mesa State College).

Maggie Frezzotti, Montana Softball Assistant Coach

Coach Frezzotti just completed her first season on staff as an assistant coach, primarily responsible for hitting and catching. She assisted in guiding Montana to their 4th consecutive Big Sky Conference Tournament appearance. Prior to Montana, she spent a season coaching at Eastern Michigan University, where she oversaw pitch calling, catching, and assisted with hitting. Prior to her time at Eastern Michigan University, she spent three years at Concordia University Ann Arbor. As a player, she played internationally representing Team Argentina for 13 years, participating in important competitions such as two World Championships, two Pan-American Games, and one World Cup. In 2017 she was selected to the all-tournament team as a catcher in the Pan-American qualifier (Santo Domingo). Also in 2017, she was nominated to the "Olympia Awards" as the best softball player of Argentina.

Additional Camp Instructors include current collegiate softball coaches and current and former players of the Griz Softball team. Ratio 6:1.

As a potential participant of the **Initial** Griz Softball Summer Elite Day Camp, I could possibly sustain injuries no matter how well conditioned I may be. Depending on the nature of the sport, injuries may be minor to fatal in nature. Some specific injuries that may be sustained by participants in physical activity associated with sports such as this one are as follows: stoppage of breathing, spine and neck injuries (either of which could result in paralysis), concussion, heart failure, broken legs, feet, ankles, toes or other bones, heat stroke, heat cramp, heat exhaustion, stroke, convulsion, unconsciousness, abrasions to limbs such as arms, legs and head, fainting, sudden illness, cramps, and loss of wind.

Physical contact poses risks in **Initial** Griz Softball Summer Elite Day Camp activities as well, even though it occurs regularly as an accepted part of the sport. The propensity for major injuries, such as injuries to the spinal column, broken bones, concussion and internal injuries to major organs increases in relation to the force of impact upon contact or collision. I understand the risk of injury due to the force of a collision. I realize that if I have physical problems such as a heart condition, hypertension, orthopedic problems, or other medical problems, I should consult a physician concerning any limits to my activity.

I agree to comply with all camp rules and regulations, including those given verbally and in writing. I also agree to participate in safety meetings and the presentation of any safety material, such as a video on safety, which are designed and offered to promote safety in all camp activities.
